

PROTOCOL

SITUATION

SUSPECTED RECRUITMENT OR ACTUAL EXPLOITATION BY STUDENT

- 1 Involve on-site school resource officer (SRO) for possible investigation
- 2 Investigate possible campus impact recruitment, harassment, involvement of other students, safety issues on campus, etc.
- 3 Provide school consequence, if appropriate, and law enforcement may make an arrest depending on outcome of investigation
- 4 SRO to input relevant information into the Law Enforcement Human Trafficking website if sufficient and/or reliable evidence exists

SUSPECTED VICTIM OF CSEC

- 1 Involve on-site school resource officer (SRO) for possible investigation
- 2 If child abuse or neglect is suspected, submit Child Welfare Services report with as much detail as possible
- 3 Investigate possible campus impact recruitment, harassment, involvement of other students, safety issues on campus, etc.
- 4 If appropriate, and in consultation with the victim, contact and inform guardian or parent of potential victimization
- 5 Offer potential victim and/or parent/guardian a referral to appropriate counseling or social services
- 6 Set up regular contact with victim and periodically check on status

(Most appropriate for counselor or social worker)

CONFIRMED VICTIM OF CSEC

- 1 Involve on-site school resource officer (SRO) for possible investigation
- 2 Submit Child Welfare Services report with as much detail as possible
- 3 Investigate possible campus impact recruitment, harassment, involvement of other students, safety issues on campus, etc.
- 4 SRO to conduct investigation or refer to appropriate investigation unit
- 5 If appropriate, and in consultation with the victim, contact and inform guardian or parent of victim
- 6 Investigate whether the school placement is appropriate for the student, if not, work with the appropriate department to transfer the student
- 7 Offer victim a referral to appropriate counseling or social services, set up regular contact with victim and periodically check on status
